Mr. Kurzban:

In a letter dated March 15, 2004 we terminated your agreement to represent the Government of Haiti, the Bank of the Republic of Haiti ("BRH"), and Telecommunications of Haiti S.A.M. ("Teleco"). In a further letter dated November 11, 2004, we requested that you surrender certain documents and information related to the services your firm has provided to the Government of Haiti over the past several years. The purpose of this letter is to renew and clarify our request, and to request further that you immediately turn over to our counsel, Winston & Strawn, all documents, without limitation, related in any way to your retention by or representation of the Government of Haiti, BRH and/or Teleco.

Specifically, by close of business on October 12, 2005, we ask that you surrender to Winston & Strawn, without limitation, the following documents: (i) any correspondence between yourself or any individual in your firm and any present or former official, employee, agent, or member of the Government of Haiti, including BRH and Teleco, during the period of your representation; (ii) any document provided to you or your firm by any present or former official, employee, agent, or member of the Government of Haiti, including BRH and Teleco, during the period of your representation; (iii) any document provided to any present or former official, employee, agent, or member of the Government of Haiti, including BRH and Teleco, from you or your firm during the period of your representation; (iv) any documentation of services provided by yourself or your firm to any present or former official, employee, agent, or member of the Government of Haiti, including BRH and Teleco, during the period of your representation, including all time sheets and billing records; (v) any document received or generated by your firm in the course of negotiations with third parties and/or as a paying agent on behalf of the Government of Haiti, including BRH and Teleco; (vi) any document relating to any payment to any account not held in the name of the Government of Haiti, BRH or Teleco, including without limitation any personal account or account controlled by or for the benefit of any present or former official, employee, agent, or member of the Government of Haiti, including BRH and Teleco, or their agents, associates or family members; and (vii) any other document generated in the course of your and your firm's relationship with the Government of Haiti, including BRH and Teleco.

In response to our request of November 11, 2004, you stated that you were "constrained to restrict [your] communications [with us] based on the competing claims of legitimate entitlement to act on behalf of the

Republic of Haiti," and in your letter of March 16, 2004, you stated that "a conflict exists as to the identity of the lawful government of Haiti" As you must know, the United States has unequivocally recognized Haiti's acting government as the sole legitimate government of Haiti. A summary of the U.S. State Department's position, which confirms Mr. Aristide's noninvolvement in the current Haitian government, is available on the State Department's official website and reads, in relevant part:

On February 29, 2004, Jean-Bertrand Aristide submitted his resignation as President of Haiti and flew on a chartered plane to the Central African Republic. Boniface Alexandre, President (chief justice) of Haiti's Supreme Court, assumed office as interim President in accordance with Haiti's constitution.

See U.S. DEPT. OF STATE, BUREAU OF WESTERN HEMISPHERE AFFAIRS, Background Note: Haiti, http://www.state.gov/r/pa/ei/bgn/1982.htm. In light of your own government's stated position, we trust that your previous concerns will not hinder your ability to comply fully with our request.

As you also know, you have an affirmative duty to comply with our request under the Florida Rules of Professional Conduct. Rule 4-1.16 requires that, upon termination, you take all practicable steps to protect a previous client's interests, including "surrendering papers and property to which the client is entitled." Rule 4-1.4 further demands that you "promptly comply with reasonable requests for information."

We further ask that, in addition to your immediate production of the documents noted above, you identify in writing all documents that you once possessed or controlled, and which otherwise are responsive to our request, but which you no longer possess or control. In each such instance, please explain the circumstances regarding the fate of such documents.

Finally, we hereby instruct you *not* to destroy or otherwise alter, damage, or divest yourself of your control over any such documents -- other than to return such documents to the representatives of Government of Haiti as herein demanded.

Absent prompt compliance with our requests, the Government of Haiti will avail itself of all of its rights, as appropriate, including the immediate initiation of disciplinary and civil proceedings.

A representative of Winston & Strawn will be contacting you shortly to arrange for the transfer of the documents requested to their firm. Please address any further correspondence concerning this matter to Winston & Strawn. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding on this matter.

Dear Mr. Magloire:

I write in response to your letter of November 11, 2004. You inquire as to services provided by our firm and disbursements over an eight-year period.

Please be advised that the scope of work and services performed by our firm for the period of 1996 to 2004 are the subject of written contracts between our firm and the Republic of Haiti and the Bank of the Republic of Haiti. In addition, we routinely corresponded with our client and provided status reports as requested. To the extent your are authorized to review these government records, I believe that these documents will answer your first question. Once you review the contracts you will easily be able to reconcile payments made to our firm.

I am enclosing documentation as to disbursements from 1996 through June 2004. Hopefully these records will be deemed sufficient.

With all due respect, I note that I am constrained to restrict my communications based on the competing claims of legitimate entitlement to act on behalf of the Republic of Haiti. I raised this issue about seven months ago and the Republic of Haiti responded that it had no interest in attempting to resolve the competing claims. As a consequence, I am pleased to offer you public records that identify the types of government records that will assist you in your reconciliation efforts, but I am unable to discuss specific client matters with you at this time.

I have answered your letter as a courtesy and to clarify false rumors that you and others have spread as to my not performing any work for the government, but you should not take my response as an indication that I regard your inquiry as legitimate.







Dear Minister Gustave and Gouverneur Joseph:



Since the beginning of this retainer, the lawyers and lobbyists working for Haiti have had a number of significant accomplishments. We have unified the Black Caucus in the United States who has submitted legislation to the U.S. Congress in the form of a declaration to the President requesting that President Bush lift the economic embargo against Haiti. On the Senate side of the U.S. Congress we are working closely with Senator Dodd to initiate hearings on the economic embargo. We are also working on the introduction of legislation in the Senate similar to that introduced in the House of Representatives.

On the legal side of these issues we are engaged in research to determine whether the Haitian government should initiate litigation against the IDB or whether individual Haitians should bring claims based on international human rights before the Interamerican Commission



on Human Rights. At the same time we have been working on the representation of Haitian migrants who have been subjected to long term detention by the INS.

In addition to the legal and political work, we have organized a Commission of International Experts on drug trafficking to address the problem of drug trafficking in Haiti The Commission made its first trip to Haiti on April 29-30, 2002. This trip included the former drug czar in the U.S., and current mayor of Los Angeles Lee Brown, the Commissioner of the Police Department for the City of New York and former Commissioner of Customs, Ray Kelley as well as academic experts in the fields of enforcement and rehabilitation. The Commission expects to work diligently toward providing a final report to the Government of Haiti in the near future.

My firm has also provided to the Government of Haiti legal support for negotiations with the United States in the form of an analysis of proposed contracts on drug trafficking and migration.

I will be happy to answer any questions that you may have.



Pursuant to our conversation, I kindly request that you take immediate action to resolve the matter concerning the government's decision to retain the services of my firm to represent its interests in the United States. It is my understanding that the matter has not been resolved between your office and the Central Bank because there may be an issue over a resolution that must be provided to the Bank to release the funds.

As you know, our obligations concerning my contract began to run on May 1, 2001. Various lobbyists and publicists working for the government have made demands upon me for payment pursuant to the agreements signed by the Minister of Finance. We are now in default of our agreement for failing to make timely payments.

I kindly request that you take immediate steps to resolve this matter. The Governor of the Bank is requiring a resolution from the Council of Minister which may be by individual signature of each minister or through a general resolution signed by your office. According to the relevant documents, the Governor has to sign the agreement in conformance with a resolution of the Council of Ministers.

As the Prime Minister you must decide with the Governor of the Bank the form and method to conclude this matter. I would not presume to express to you the best method to resolve the current problem. Nevertheless, I have numerous obligations to other persons and entities who we are now in default with as a result of our failure to pay. I would appreciate your immediate attention to this matter.

Notre travail comprendra, à titre indicatif: la représentation juridique, les litiges, les conseils juridiques, la préparation de rapports et la réalisation de projets spéciaux, sur demande du Gouvernement d'Haïti, la BRH et/ou la Téléco.

J'assumerai la responsabilité principale du présent mandat, mais suis sûr de recevoir, au besoin, l'assistance de mon cabinet. Pour faciliter notre travail avec le Gouvernement d'Haïti, la BRH et la Téléco, nous maintiendrons un bureau en Haïti, employant d'autres avocats pour représenter les diverses composantes du Gouvernement d'Haïti.

En contrepartie de notre représentation du Gouvernement d'Haïti, de la BRH et de la Téléco, le cabinet d'avocats KURZBAN KURZBAN WEINGER & TETZELI recevra des honoraires mensuels bde \$197, 083 dollars américains, à compter du ler janvier 2001, en paiement pour les prestations juridiques fournies dans le cadre du présent accord et le remboursement des dépenses encourues



pour compte du Gouvernement d'Haïti, de la BRH et de la Téléco. Les paiements devront être effectués, au plus tard, le dixième jour de chaque mois, soit par virement bancaire au compte de KURZBAN KURZBAN WEINGER & TETZELI, P.A., à la Eagle National Bank sise à 1550 Biscayne Boulevard, Miami, FL 33132 (Numéro du compte : 0103138481-06; ABA Routing #066006349), soit par lettre de crédit établie à la Eagle National Bank sur laquelle les fonds pourront être tirés, au plus tard, le dixiéme jour de chaque mois. Toutes les fois que je le juge nécessaire, une portion de ces honoraires sera allouée à d'autres conseillers qui nous aideront et nous donneront des conseils juridiques.

Il demeure entendu que le présent accord peut être résilié à n'importe quel moment, à la discrétion du Gouvernement d'Haïti, de la BRH et de la Téléco, et qu'aucun préavis n'est nécessaire, à condition, toutefois, que le cabinet soit payé au prorata du nombre des jours de services fournis durant le mois de la résiliation.

Si la présente est le reflet fidèle de notre accord, veuillez en signer l'original, le dater et nous le retourner.

Nous tenons à réitérer combien nous sommes honorés d'avoir été choisis pour vous servir et espérons que notre collaboration sera fructueuse.

Veuillez agréer, Monsieur le Gouverneur, l'expression de nos sentiments distingués.
