

EDUCATION (GENERAL) BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (GENERAL) DEGREE

Leading to career opportunities in: Education, Health, Social Work, Leisure Studies, and other related fields. The degree is designed to be awarded to students who have completed the requirements of the degree programme satisfactorily, namely with the successful completion of the course requirements, successful completion of the assessment process, and successful completion of the final project. The degree is awarded to students who have completed the requirements of the degree programme, and who have successfully completed the final project of the degree programme.

- **Students completing a general degree should obtain:** **General Degree Programme (GDP)** which includes the following modules of Mathematics and Health Development for the appropriate selected degree course leading to General Education, Health, Social Work, Leisure Studies, and other related areas, and appropriate electives (70).
- **Final Assessment of Degree:** Students will complete a final assessment project appropriate to their degree programme, and will be awarded a degree with Honours, Merit, or Pass, depending on the results achieved. Students may request a re-assessment of their final assessment project, and will be awarded a degree with Honours, Merit, or Pass (75).
- **Students completing a Health, Social Work, or Leisure Studies degree should obtain:** **Health, Social Work, or Leisure Studies Degree Programme (HSWLDSP)** which includes the following modules of Health, Social Work, or Leisure Studies, and appropriate electives, and will be awarded a degree with Honours, Merit, or Pass (75).
- **Final Assessment of Degree:** Students will complete a final assessment project appropriate to their degree programme, and will be awarded a degree with Honours, Merit, or Pass, depending on the results achieved. Students may request a re-assessment of their final assessment project, and will be awarded a degree with Honours, Merit, or Pass (75).
