A CIA legacy lives on

**O**n November 3, a truck crashed into a Mercedes Benz in Istanbul, sixty miles south of Izmir, and killed three Turkish passengers: a fugitive heroin smuggler and hitman, a former high-ranking police officer, and a former "Man of Cinema." The lone survivor was a rightwing member of parliament. In the car's trunk, police found a forged passport, police identification papers, ammunition, silencers, and machine guns.
