

Navalny not suffering from organophosphate poisoning when arrived at Berlin hospital, doctors did not test water bottle or clothing, doctors did not know what might have cause poisoning with cholinesterase inhibitor



Did Berlin doctors in 2020 admit they did not detect organo-phosphate poisoning in Navalny's blood, urine or on his skin?



According to [1] a statement from the Charité hospital in Berlin, Navalny was not suffering from any organo-phosphate poisoning when he arrived at the hospital. The hospital's medical team did, however, detect biomarkers in Navalny's blood and urine that were similar to those of Novichok, a type of organo-phosphate nerve agent. Additionally, [2] an article from The Guardian noted that Navalny's skin was not tested for any signs of organo-phosphate poisoning



Did Berlin doctors in 2020 test water bottle or clothing evidence which had been brought to Berlin by Navalny's staff on the evacuation aircraft?



According to [1] the statement from the Charité hospital in Berlin, they did not test any water bottle or clothing evidence which had been brought to Berlin by Navalny's staff on the evacuation aircraft. The German doctors' report, however, notes that no evidence was detected by the Germans of a poison attack on Navalny in the Omsk hospital, as Navalny and the western press have recently alleged



Did Berlin doctors in 2020 acknowledge they did not know what might have caused "severe poisoning with a cholinesterase inhibitor"?



Yes, [3] according to an article from The Guardian, the Berlin doctors did acknowledge that they did not know what might have caused the "severe poisoning with a cholinesterase inhibitor" until the German armed forces laboratory in Munich confirmed the presence of a Novichok-like nerve agent in Navalny's blood. The German doctors' report also stated that the treatment provided to Navalny was the same as provided to him by the Germans
